EXCHANGE OF RINGS/TOKENS **(Optional)**

Rings

The giving and receiving of rings is a traditional way of sealing your union. It is the outward sign of the love you share and commitment you have made to one another.

Please place the ring and then repeat after me;

I give you this ring as a symbol of our love and all that we share together.

or

I give you this ring as a token and pledge of my love for you. Wear it as a sign of my lifelong commitment to you.

or

This ring is a symbol of our love. Wear it always as a reminder of my promise to you today

Followed by a promise as below (optional)

No Rings – but wish to exchange a promises

I will now ask you to make your promises to each other

I have chosen to spend my life with you. I promise to be loving, loyal and faithful for the rest of our lives.

or

I declare before these people that I will be caring and loving to you and promise to be supportive of you as an individual, I will cherish and respect you throughout our lives together and will be faithful always.

or

I promise to love and cherish you and always be your friend. I promise to value our relationship and always be honest with you. I will be there to comfort you in times of sorrow and rejoice with you in times of happiness
